The meeting was called to order. Paul made a motion that was seconded by Kathi to approve the minutes from the April 15th, 2025, meeting. The vote to approve was unanimous.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**TREASURER REPORT:**

**Bills:**

Five bills were presented for payment. The BSRD board reviewed the bills. Paul made a motion that was seconded by Kathi to pay the bills. The vote to approve was unanimous.

1. Darrin Goodrick-----\$ 340.00 - Project work for BSRD.
2. Darrin Goodrick-----\$ 5020.00 - Various projects for BSRD (Mowing, sign replacement, sign installation, etc.)
3. Road and Driveway-----\$ 41,826.83 - Prepayment for paving project on N. Oceania.
4. Traffic Logix-----\$ 6,844.00 - Payment for SADS project.
5. Waldport Tech-----\$ 50.00 - Payment for tech services.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Oceania Sand Ordinance:

Paul reports that he has received a response from BSRD legal counsel that stated he has spoken with Lincoln County legal counsel regarding the Lincoln County Sheriff's request for verification and language clarification in the sand ordinance. BSRD is waiting for a response from the Sheriff's department.

**TRAFFIC LOGIX UPDATE:**

Paul reports that the SAD devices for the Cunard project have been ordered. We are waiting to get a delivery date so we can coordinate an estimated installation date from Darrin Goodrick.

**PAINTING UPDATE:**

Dennis is to contact several painting contractors to get estimates on the painting project on N. Oceania after the paving project is done. This also will include touching up various areas of fading center lines and speed humps lines.

**NORTH OCEANIA FOGLINE:**

The Bayshore HOA Board has reviewed the multiple recommendations from Kittelson Engineering on safety walking paths on N. Oceania. The HOA Board presented the various options to the Bayshore property owners. A majority of the poll of owners voted to accept the 4.5' wide walking path on both sides of N. Oceania. BSRD voted unanimously to go along with the 4.5-foot fog lines. The painting estimates will reflect this decision.

**FAQ section on BSRD website:**

The BSRD Board reviewed the FAQ section of our website and determined it to be adequate. Further updates can be done if necessary.

**ABANDONED VEHICLE:**

Paul gave an update on the abandoned vehicle on S. Oceania. BSRD has no jurisdiction on abandoned vehicles on the roadside in Bayshore.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

2025-2026 BSRD Budget:

At the next BSRD meeting the board will look at and decide what next year's budget request will be.

**BAYSHORE LOOP FOGLINE:**

The BSRD will get estimates for painting the fog lines at the intersection of Bayshore Loop/Bayshore Drive.

**Safety Issue:**

The BSRD was contacted by a Bayshore resident regarding a speeding issue on North Oceania. Paul will contact the Lincoln County Road District to see about obtaining a data collection device(s) to see if further action is necessary.

**STREET WIDENING REQUEST FROM A BAYSHORE RESIDENT:**

Paul has received a street widening request from a Bayshore resident. Paul talked with the resident and informed them that because of legal issues that decision needs to come from the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners.

**KITTELSON ENGINEERING REQUEST:**

Kittelson Engineering has contacted BSRD to see if they are interested in writing up a story to go on their website regarding our history and how we function in Bayshore. Paul will contact them to see exactly what this might involve.
